


## Virtual CISO : Cyber security at your fingertips

The importance of securing your data has never been greater. Security incidents regularly affect businesses of all sizes and often cause irreversible reputational damage to the companies involved. The average cost of a data breach in Australia is \$3.9million<sup>1</sup>, an increase of 31%.

Businesses operating in the digital workplace can no longer ignore the risks. The scale and severity of cyber threats has evolved, and the ability to effectively manage risk now requires an extensive skill set.

The role of the Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) is a critical one. The CISO is the executive responsible for an organisation's information and data security - aligning security strategy and corporate objectives while minimising the financial, reputational and compliance risks that may arise from a data breach.

The challenge facing CISOs in this ever-changing environment is the need for constant upskilling. This introduces the question of whether a company should be investing in an internal resource to manage security or outsourcing this service to a team of experts.
